### **About Jericho Project**

Jericho Project is a nationally-acclaimed nonprofit ending homelessness at its roots by enabling homeless individuals and families to attain quality housing, employment and mental and physical health services. The 34-year-old nonprofit serves over 2,500 individuals, including 700 veterans, annually. Jericho has been a key partner in New York City's initiative to end veterans' homelessness, and is leading bold, innovative strategies to do the same for families and young adults.

Our programs touch four cornerstones of a person's life: housing, employment, wellness and family stability. We create a culture of "moving on" through a foundation of housing and supportive services provided by expert program specialists and case managers. We have over 400 units of supportive housing including 8 residences in the Bronx and Harlem, as well as scatter-site apartments throughout NYC.

#### **About the Position**

Jericho Project is seeking qualified clinician (LCSW or similar) to provide ongoing part time counseling for Walton House, an 89-unit Permanent Supportive Housing program which will house 33 young adults and 56 HUD VASH veterans. Qualified candidate would serve as LGBTQ and also have a history of working with young adult individuals with mental illness and substance abuse histories; experience in a supportive housing setting is preferred. A candidate with experience serving veterans is a plus. The candidate should provide services with an awareness of, sensitivity to, and respect for diverse o culture, ethnicity, gender identity, physical and mental abilities, sexual attraction, race, and spirituality or religion. Potential candidates should have experience in quality assurance, program management, NYC shelter systems, team building, housing placement, and supervision.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- The successful candidate will have experience providing evidence based treatments (CBT, DBT, Motivational interviewing, etc.) to a wide range of diagnoses.
- ➤ Complete clinical assessments, biopsychosocial, etc.
- Must be comfortable working in an interdisciplinary approach and collaborating with colleagues on the service plans of clients.
- ➤ Maintain electronic case records and notes that sufficiently show the work being done and progress towards service goals.
- ➤ Identify resources in the community for clients and create/maintain linkages. Psychiatric services will be the main focus along with other preventive services, mental and physical healthcare, to meet individualized service goals.
- Participate in programming weekly supervision, case conferences, staff meeting, and training.
- > Carry out duties as assigned by Program Director.

### **Requirements:**

- Licensed Clinical Social Worker, or similar.
- ➤ Candidate must have at least three years' experience working with young adults or victims of trauma for populations such as people with substance abuse disorders, those with psychiatric illness or those who have experiences homelessness.
- > Experience with LGBTQ population required
- ➤ Ability to manage caseload of at least 15
- ➤ Candidate must possess superior written and verbal skills
- ➤ Candidate must be well-organized and possess multitasking skills
- > Training in evidence based practices
- ➤ Bilingual Spanish/English is a plus
