About Jericho Project

Jericho Project is a nationally-acclaimed nonprofit ending homelessness at its roots by enabling homeless individuals and families to attain quality housing, employment and mental and physical health services. The 36-year-old nonprofit serves over 2,500 individuals, including 700 veterans, annually. Jericho has been a key partner in New York City's initiative to end veterans' homelessness, and is leading bold, innovative strategies to do the same for families and young adults.

Our programs touch four cornerstones of a person's life: housing, employment, wellness, and family stability. We create a culture of "moving on" through a foundation of housing and supportive services provided by expert program specialists and case managers.

We have over 550 units of supportive housing including 9 residences in the Bronx, Harlem, and Astoria, as well as scatter-site apartments throughout NYC.

About the Position

Jericho Project is seeking a qualified clinician, LCSW, to provide ongoing counseling for four of our supportive housing residents throughout the Bronx and Manhattan. The qualified applicant will work in three of our Permanent Supportive Housing residents in the Bronx and one in Harlem serving formerly homeless adults. Candidates must have experience serving a wide range of individuals with mental illnesses and substance abuse histories; experience in a supportive housing setting is preferred. The candidate should provide services with an awareness of, sensitivity to, and respect for diversity of culture, ethnicity, gender identity, physical and mental abilities, sexual attraction, race, and spirituality or religion.

Responsibilities:

- Candidate must have experience providing evidence-based treatments (CBT, DBT, Motivational interviewing, etc.) to a wide range of diagnoses.
- Provide ongoing psychotherapy and counseling for a caseload of approximately 25-30 clients at a time, serving at least 50 clients per year.
- > Provide diverse range of counseling and interventions depending on the needs of the clients.
- Complete clinical assessments, biopsychosocial assessments, safety plans, treatment plans, psychiatric evals etc.
- Demonstrate improved functioning utilizing evidenced based assessments/scales (ex. Beck Depression Inventory, PCL-5)

- Maintain case records and notes that sufficiently show the work being done and progress towards treatment goals.
- ➢ Facilitate groups as needed.
- Must be comfortable working in an interdisciplinary approach and collaborating with colleagues on the comprehensive treatment of clients.
- Review psychiatric incidents and assist with response for clients on their caseload and provide consultation on other clients from assigned sites.
- Maintain record of psychiatric hospitalizations for clients on caseload. Coordinate discharge plan with hospital and Case Management staff.
- Identify resources in the community for clients and create/maintain linkages. Linkages to psychiatric services will be the focus. Therapist will also make recommendations for Case Management referrals including other preventive services, mental and physical healthcare, and SPOA services, to meet individualized service goals and support work of the Case Management staff.
- Provide trainings to staff members as appropriate to meet the needs of the programs and agency.
- Participate in daily check ins with Program Directors, site programming, supervision, individual case conferences, and training.
- Carry out duties as assigned by Supervising LCSW and Program Director(s).

Requirements:

- Licensed Clinical Social Worker.
- Candidate must have at least three years' experience working with victims of trauma for populations such as people with substance abuse disorders, those with mental illness or those who have experienced homelessness.
- > Experience with a broad range of populations required.
- > Candidate must possess superior written and verbal skills.
- Candidate must be well-organized and possess multitasking skills.
- Training in evidence-based practices.
- Bilingual Spanish/English is a plus.
