### **Logan Fountain Groundbreaking Ceremony**



On December 14, Hudson Companies, Jericho Project and HELP USA joined partners and elected officials to break ground on Logan Fountain - a new mixed-use development, supportive and affordable residence and shelter, in East New York. When complete, the eastern wing will create

174 new affordable apartments, including 105 supportive housing units for formerly homeless individuals. On-site services are provided by the Jericho Project and are funded by the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene's (NYC DOHMH) NYC 15/15 program. Building amenities include a fitness room, landscaped common courtyard with a children's play area, multiple terraces with a garden area, bicycle storage rooms, and laundry rooms.

**Anthony Avenue Building Progress** 





There are some exciting news regarding the progress of the renovations at Anthony Avenue! The team working on this project is currently making significant strides in working through obtaining a Temporary Certificate of Occupation and scheduling inspections, with a target of achieving a TCO at the 1842 property by early June. During a recent punch list walk through, the units were found to be in excellent condition, which is a affirmation to the hard work and dedication of the team. Although there is still some construction work remaining in the lower level, rear yard, and exterior/interior lifts, the delivery of the DEP-approved gravel and the imminent start of the concrete pour and rubble foundation work are positive indicators that the project is on track.

Additionally, the Con Edison gas meter installation and permanent power are expected to be completed in the next two weeks, which is an excellent step forward.

We're excited to see the final product of the Anthony Avenue project!

### **Recent Grants Awarded to Jericho Project**

Bank of America Charitable Foundation gave in support of our Workforce Opportunities Program (WfO). This grant will be used to strengthen the program, which utilizes an individualized approach in helping Jericho clients and residents achieve their professional goals. WfO programing is comprised of workshops, training, referrals to educational courses, job search assistance and much more.

BlackRock Charitable Foundation also awarded Jericho Project a grant in support of our Workforce Opportunities Program (WfO). WfO provides services to more than 60% of Jericho Project's residents. On average clients who participate in the Workforce Opportunities program have an hourly wage of \$17.25 for full-time employees.

We have some exciting news to share about the recent Horticultural Therapy

Update provided by Jonathan Castro and Allandra-Marie Mc Eachrane!

Just over a month ago, the team built elevated raised beds at our Walton and Kingsbridge Terrace residences, and planted a variety of vegetables, fruits, and herbs. The raised beds are designed to be accessible for tenants with physical limitations, such as those who use walkers or wheelchairs, allowing them to fully participate in the project. The team has managed to cultivate tomatoes and strawberries, as well as a variety of other fruits and vegetables. Additionally, some radishes are expected to be ready for harvest in just two short weeks.

Jonathan and Allandra have done an excellent job of bringing this project to life, and we are proud to have them on our team!




